

What does eXtension provide?



Provides web based platforms and systems for knowledge providers to network and provide information and advice to knowledge users 24/7/365

By 2017 we each will have 5 internet devices



What does eXtension provide users?

24/7/365 day access via any internet device



What does extension provide users? Cont...

1. A **coordinated** approach in subject areas to provide on-line support in various forms:

Frequently asked questions

Fact sheets

Chat sessions/discussion groups

Decision support tools/distance diagnostics

Web conferencing/video streaming

Education modules

How does eXtension work?

It connects knowledge providers (Communities of Practice)

with knowledge users (Communities of Interest)

Communities of Practice

"A broad range of content providers/experts (from a range of agencies), who share knowledge or competence and are willing to work and learn together and share knowledge with users via educational products and programs"



Communities of Interest

People with common interests and issues that use Communities of Practice as a resource

Learning Network

Where Communities of Practice and Communities of Interest engage, share information and provide expertise for the benefit of both parties





What will the pilot grains eXtension initiative involve?

A national pilot of two eXtension learning networks (that include Communities of Practice and Interest)

Crop pathology



Crop nutrition



Via an agreement between eXtension USA, USDA, GRDC, DEPI, coordinated through the Grains national R, D and E implementation committee

&

Broad industry engagement/participation in the pilot Communities of Practice and then Interest
